Based on data from 21 completed** standard health surveys the average number of deficiencies cited for Massachusetts nursing homes is 7.8 under the new survey process and new requirements of participation. The top five cited deficiencies include:

- F656 Develop/Implement Comprehensive Care Plan
- F800 Infection Prevention & Control
- F658 Services Provided Meet Professional Standards
- F700 Bedrails
- F761 Label/Store Drugs & Biologicals
