The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has released a <u>toolkit</u> highlighting innovative strategies that Medicare accountable care organizations (ACOs) use to coordinate and manage care for their diverse beneficiary populations to ensure high-quality effective care is provided at the right time and in the right setting. The toolkit includes a section on 'Coordinating Care for Beneficiaries Who Require Treatment in a SNF.'

Along with the 14-page toolkit, the agency also released seven <u>case studies</u> detailing how individual ACOs are working more closely with skilled care providers. Each case study includes detailed results and lessons learned.
